- Opening and welcome by Tony Mann (Group Chair)
 - a. Noted: @310 young people pass through each week. @60 Adult volunteers.
 - b. Opportunity for all to join to help and very much welcomed
 - c. Applauded Jo Brookbank and Michael Dreksler for the quality of the provision given at the 4^{th} .
 - d. Highlighted Jo Brookbank's British Empire Medal, awarded in the Queen's Birthday Honours list 2022 for Jo's unwavering support for children during Covid.
- Approval of last year's AGM minutes (AGM held on 27th March 2021 on zoom (previously circulated in the AGM pack)
 - Unanimously approved by the meeting, no matters arising.
- Chairs Report: Presented by Jo Brookbank (Group Scout Leader)
 - a. April 2020 is the first month we are reporting on and the changes and adaptations we have overcome have been monumental.
 - b. Scouting continued virtually throughout the Covid lockdown periods and returned to face to face as soon as restrictions were lifted.
 - c. Parents need to be thanked for supporting their young people to "get online" each week and in coping with keeping 2 meters apart initially.
 - d. Our public fireworks display was cancelled in 2020 but was followed it up with our 1st Santa's campfire grotto experience. This was such a huge success it was repeated again in 2021. Fireworks 2021 fully sold out.



- e. The group has continued to grow.
- f. Squirrels launched in September 2021
- g. During the lockdown, the site was improved. First installing outdoor sinks and an outdoor shelter and additionally the larger bouldering wall was progressed, to be completed end summer 2022.
- h. Plans to improve our toilet facilities, rebuild the adventure trail and further outdoor storage were put on hold but are looking to complete later this year.
- i. It was confirmed that the delivery of activities was the priority, even when short of volunteers. Jo Brookbank ended by saying that they welcome anyone with any skills to support Scouting.

 - i. Accounts were adopted unanimously by a show of virtual hands
 - ii. Accounts were circulated prior to the meeting and in the AGM Pack.
 - b. NOTED: 2 Years of Financial Reports 2020-2021 and 2021 2022
 - i. 2020-2021 saw Subs fees reduced during COVID due to inability to meet but back up to £27,720 in 2021-2022.
 - ii. Grants include Covid relief funding £21k+ in 2020-2021 and £10k+ Covid Omicron grant in 2021-2022 period.
 - iii. Back into scouting: Total income 2021-2022 £55,791.
 - iv. The largest single expense to the group continues to be our annual membership fees (currently 48% of subs) which goes to support leader training, the national scout organisation, and county and district facilities.
 - v. 2021-2022 Dip into Expenses for @£11k camps (ie Intl Jamboree), and Equipment, ie: Camping Equipment, Outdoor Shelter and Bouldering wall.
 - vi. 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 spending on improvements and maintenance ie: Scout Hut flooring and improvements in security following break-in.
 - vii. 2020-2021 Profit £15,685 2021-2022 Profit £16,500
 - viii. 2020-2021 Funds £57,884 2021-2022 Funds £74,385
